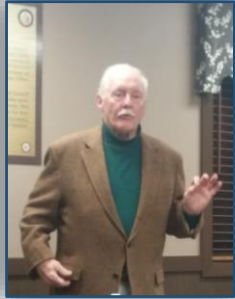


MG Informational Meeting – Ins and Outs of POA
